Reception and departure

Delftse Poort reception is open from Monday to Friday from 08:00 – 18:00.
 The Arcadis reception on the 9th floor is open from Monday to Friday from 08:00 – 15:30

Upon arrival, please check in at the reception desk at Delftse Poort (via (escalator) stairs in the central hall) to receive a pass for the access gates to the elevator area. Check in to the Arcadis reception on the 9th floor where you will receive a visitor badge (wear visibly) and a coffee/teacup for use during your stay. Return both items at the reception desk upon departure. If you are leaving after 17:00, please leave the visitor badge and cup at the reception desk. Your Arcadis contact person will accompany you to the Delftse Poort reception after your meeting.



Route to the office

From Hofplein you drive onto Weena. Past the second side street on the right, you will find the Delftse Poort building. When you have reached the building, turn right (this street is also called Delftse Poort). At the end, turn left at the Delftseplein.

Take the 2nd entrance on the left, parking garage P2 (you can enter via license plate registration). You have access to the office through the garage. In the central hall on the 3rd floor (via (escalator) stairs in central hall). Please check in at reception B.



Bicycle parking

There is a public bicycle parking at Rotterdam Central Station.



Company restaurant

The restaurant Kuster is open from Monday to Friday from 11.30 to 13.30. The coffee bar is open from Monday to Friday from 08:00 to 16:00.



Other Information

If you are coming to visit Arcadis Rotterdam, you must be registered at least 1 day in advance at the reception of the Delftse Poort. Your Arcadis contact person will facilitate this for you.

Parking Information

If you would like to use our parking garage (free of charge) during your visit, please report this at least a day in advance with your license plate number at the Arcadis reception, via receptie.rdam@arcadis.com. The entrance to the parking garage is located on the Delftse plein. The door only opens by license plate recognition. Parking in P2 on floors 1 and 2.

Not registered?

Park at P+R Proveniersplein or alternatively, the public parking garage Schouwburgplein (Weenatunnel 50).



Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

There are 24 charging points for electric cars in the P2 car park. When the car is charged, we request it to be moved.



Public Transport

Rotterdam office is located near Rotterdam Central Station

Train

Upon arrival by train, tram, metro, or bus at Rotterdam Central Station, exit the station via the main entrance on the city center side. On the left side, you will see two towers of the Delftse Poort building. The main entrance is located at the corner of Weena and Stationsplein.

By car

Traveling to our office in Rotterdam by public transport is preferred. If not otherwise possible, we recommend making use of a P+R location due to limited parking availability. The nearest P+R is located at Proveniersplein.



Evacuation & Assembly point

Does the evacuation signal sound? Immediately leave the building through the nearest emergency exit. Always follow the instructions of the Emergency Response Team. The general assembly point is located at Kruisplein.
